What is it for?


These forms provide a structured document to **assess, plan and evaluate care** given to **all Critical Care patients**.

Who can use it?

All registered professionals caring for **all Critical Care Patients**.

How frequently should they be completed?

- **Critical Care Nursing Assessment:** on admission and at the beginning of each day and night shift.
- **The Critical Care Nursing Evaluation:** at the end of every shift.*



*For staff on a Late or Twilight shift, if the Critical Care Nursing Assessment has been completed for that shift, you only need to complete the Critical Care Nursing Evaluation.
