Please note the use of specialty mattresses will reduce the bed rail height clearance. This reduces the patient safety features of the bed rail. Please ensure the patient is aware and able to seek assistance if required.

Please consider use of low profile bed, placement of patient into enhanced care/falls risk bay as appropriate to reduce risk of falls over bed rails. Also consider intentional rounding.

Please ensure that bed rails are discussed with the patient and or/carer.
