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New Features

Mental Health Alerts in the Single Patient View

Applies to: All Users

The *Mental Health Alerts* displays any **severe** alert data brought back from LYPFT (Leeds and York Partnerships Foundation Trust - The Mental Health Trust) on the initial Single Patient View. Most mental health information can be found on the *Mental Health* tab but these alerts give important information which users need to know straight away. As such, they have been displayed more prominently:

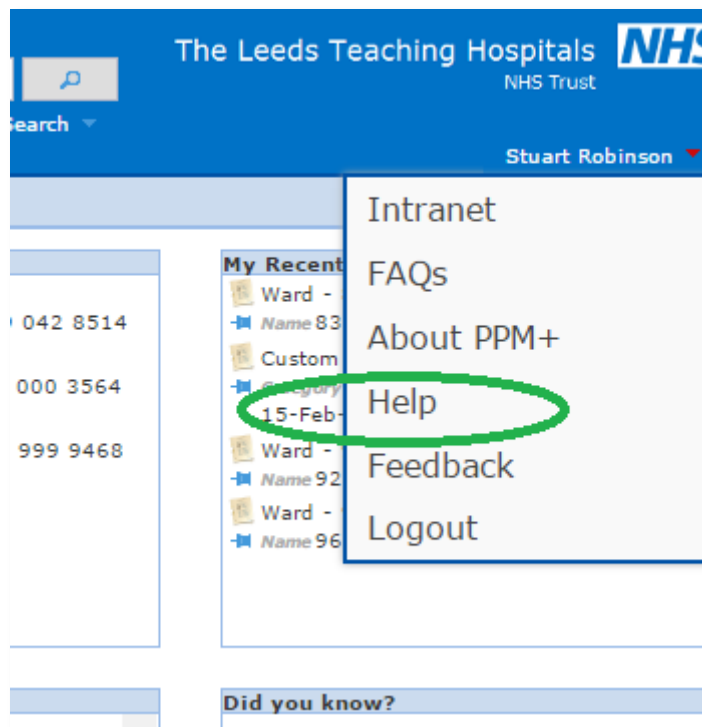

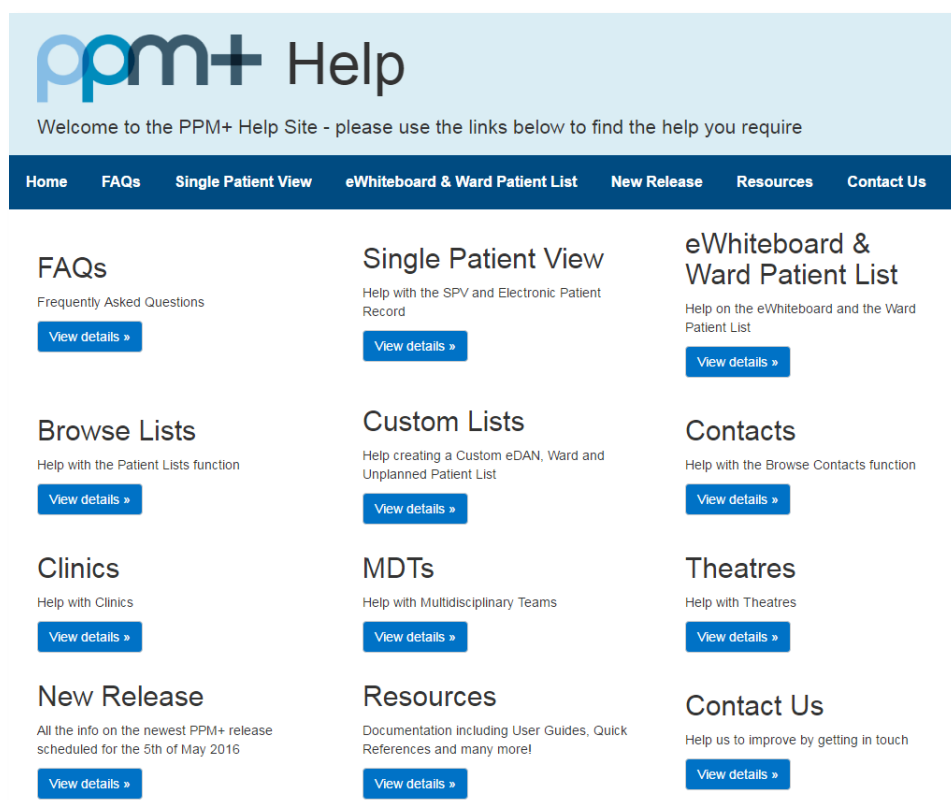



Reduction in Unnecessary eForms

Applies to: All Users

Users who have started a form in PPM+ and selected the cross  in the top-right of the form will no longer find the form in the draft section of Clinical Documents. Instead, to reduce the amount of unnecessary eForms for each patient the form will now be discarded.

Multi-page Sorting Improvement

Applies to: All Users

Now, if you are sorting your multi-page ward list or report by a column header, you will be taken to the first page of the resultant customisation regardless of the page that you are on. The below example has been sorted by *LOS* (Length of Stay) to order patients in most recent admission to least:

All eMeds Links to Launch in a New Internet Browser Tab

Applies to: eMeds Wards

To improve the eMeds experience, whenever a user clicks on an eMeds link from PPM+ (for example when completing an eDAN), it will open up in a new Internet Browser tab:






