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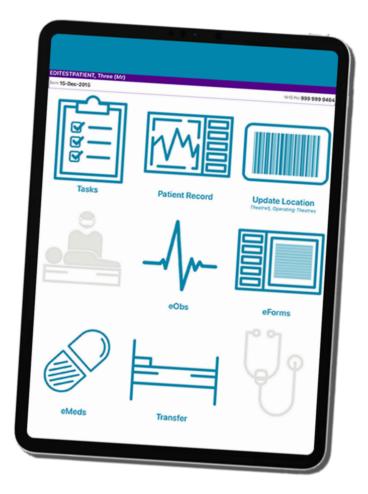
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How to Add an Assessment Record eForm/Navigate to the **Assessment Record Dashboard**

To add an Assessment Record eForm and to navigate to the Assessment Record Dashboard for a Assessment Record eForm for the first time, you need to add and complete an eForm/Clinical Document associated with the dashboard. The overall eForm/Clinical Document is called Assessment **Record**. To find out how to add an eForm/Clinical Document via the Desktop version of PPM+, please follow the Clinical Document guide by Clicking Here.

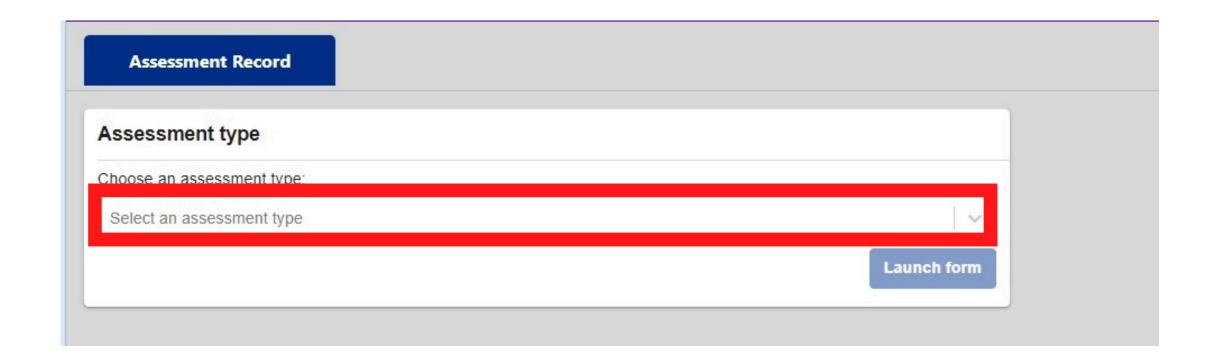




Completing an Assessment Record eForm

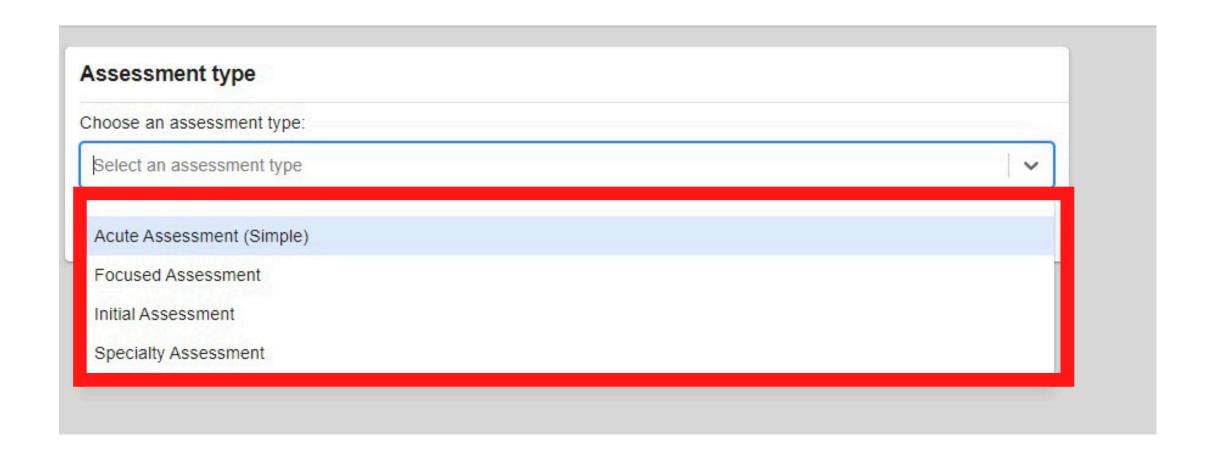


When the eForm/Dashboard opens, click within the Select an Assessment type field to chose which assessment type you wish to complete for your patient.



Click on the assessment type you wish to complete. The options to chose from are:

- Acute Assessment (Simple)
- Focused Assessment
- Initial Assessment
- Speciality Assessment



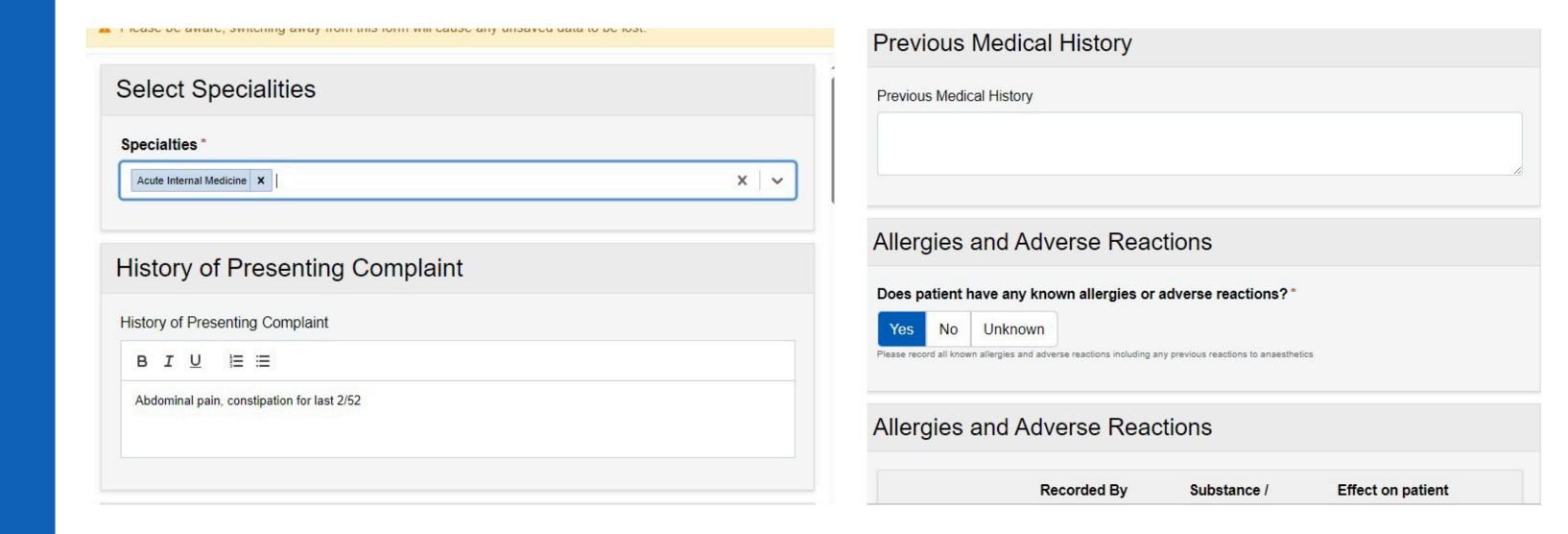


When you have selected the Assessment Record eForm you wish to complete, click on Launch form. For the purpose of this User Guide, we have selected Acute Assessment (Simple).



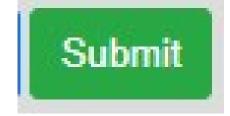


Work your way through the **Assessment Record eForm**, completing as much as possible.





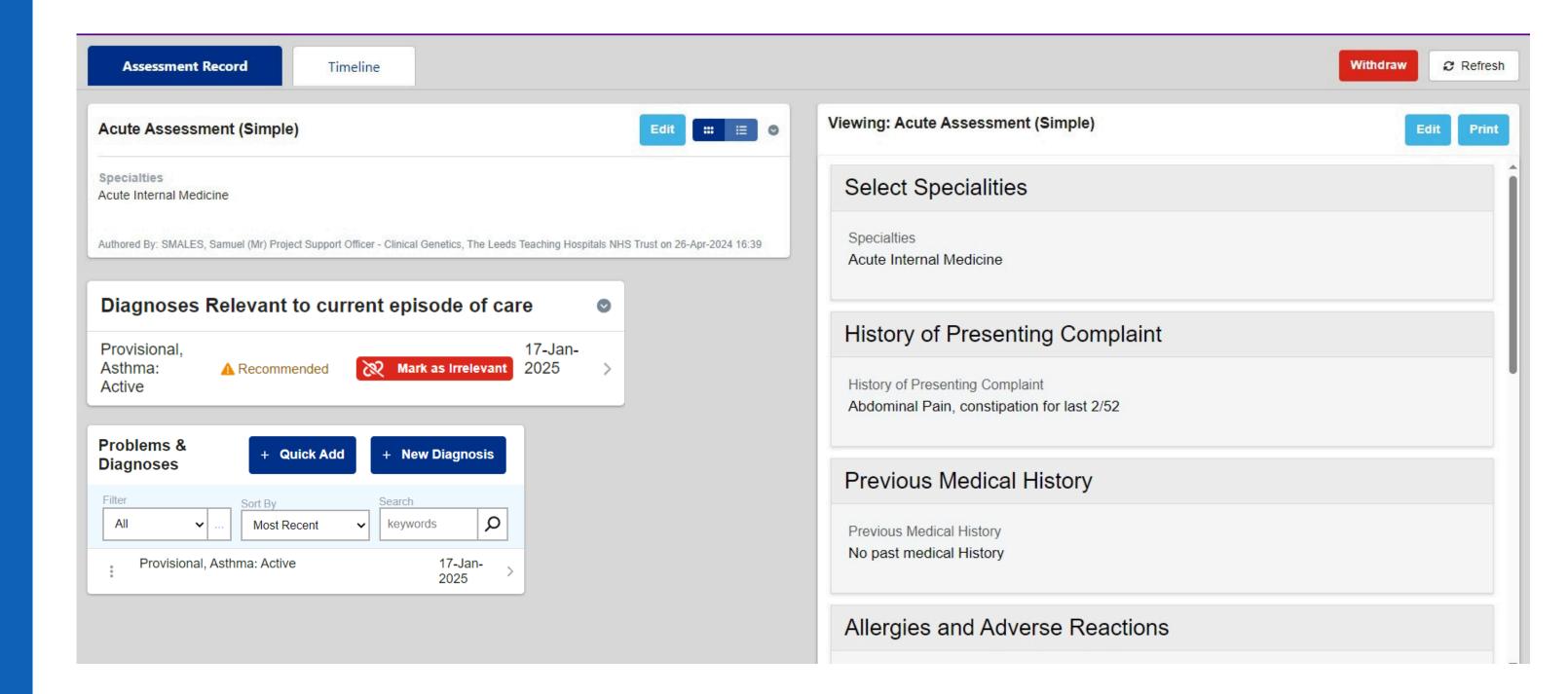
When you have completed the **Assessment Record eForm**, click on the Submit button.

The completed **Assessment Record eForm** will then be visible in it's own **Assessment Record Dashboard.**

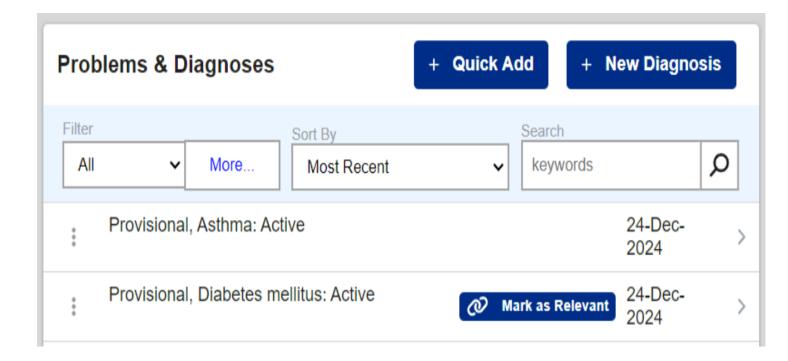


Please Note: It is possible to add another Assessment Record eForm for your patient. To do this, please repeat the steps in this User Guide starting on Page 3.

Problems & Diagnoses

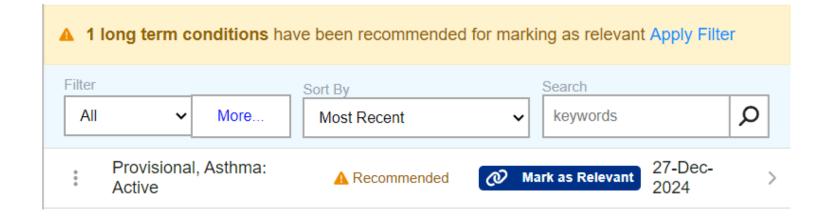
Any previous **Diagnosis** will appear in the **Problems and Diagnoses widget** in the **Assessment Record Dashboard.**

Please see the **Diagnosis user guide** to understand how to add, edit and withdraw a Diagnosis for a Patient via the **Problems & Diagnoses** widget by **Clicking Here**.



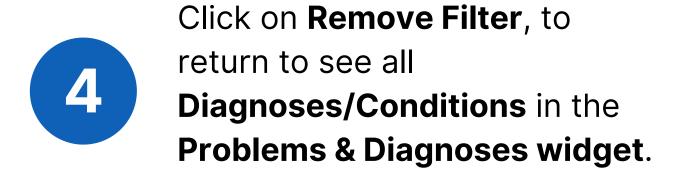
Within the **Problems & Diagnosis** widget, the system may

recommend **Diagnoses/Conditions**, that have been recorded for the Patient, that may be relevant to the Patient's current episode of care and should be considered to be marked as relevant.



Click on Apply Filter, to only see these recommended
Diagnoses/Conditions only, in the Problems & Diagnosis widget.

You can mark any **Diagnosis/Condition** as relevant to current episode of care. Click on

(a) Mark as Relevant

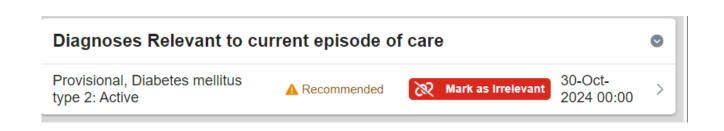
In doing so, the **Diagnosis/Condition** will appear in the **Problems & Diagnoses widget** in the **dashboard** and will also appear in the **Diagnoses Relevant to current episode of care widget in the Assessment Record Dashboard.**

Any other Dashboards with the Problems & Diagnoses widget and the Diagnoses Relevant to Episode of Care widget will also change to reflect any updates.

Diagnoses Relevant to Current Episode of Care

If any Diagnoses/Conditions have been marked as relevant for the current episode of care, it will appear in this widget. This includes Diagnoses/Conditions marked as relevant on previous admissions.

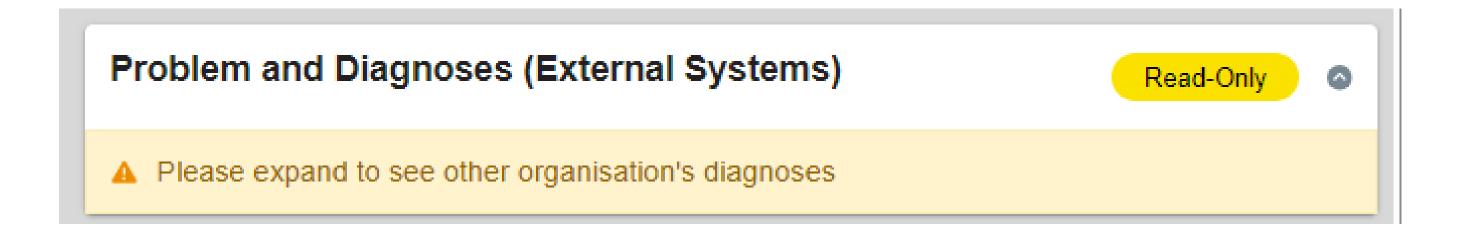
You can Mark a Diagnosis/Condition as Irrelevant for the current episode of care by clicking the Mark as Irrelevant button for a Diagnosis/Condition to remove it from the widget.



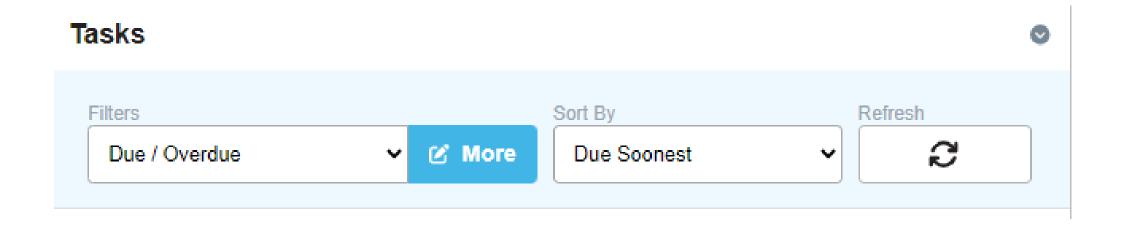
Any other Dashboards with the Problems & Diagnoses widget and the Diagnoses Relevant to Episode of Care widget will also change to reflect any updates.

Problem and Diagnoses (External Systems) and Tasks

The Problem and Diagnoses (External Systems) widget is Read Only. It will display other organisation's Diagnoses.

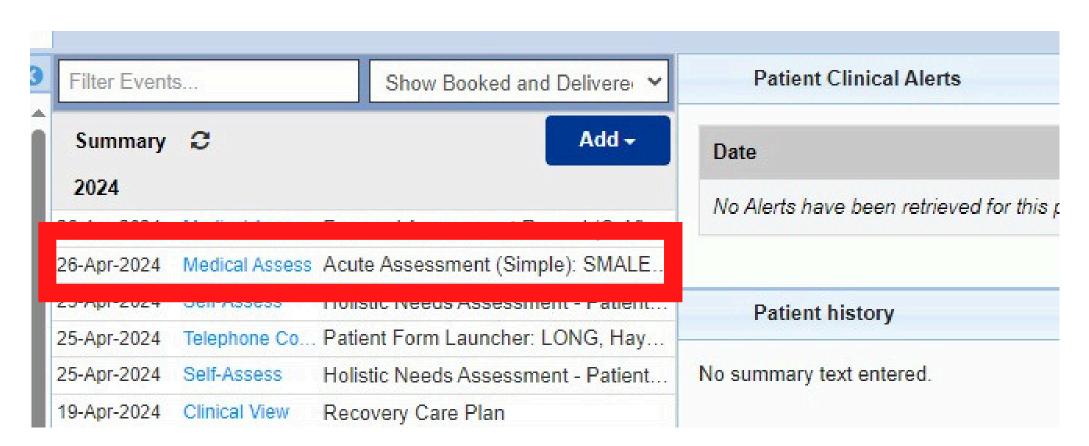


The **Task widget** shows **all tasks** for your **Patient**. The functionality of the Task widget is the same as the Task window via the Multi Patient View and Patient Tasks in the Single Patient View.

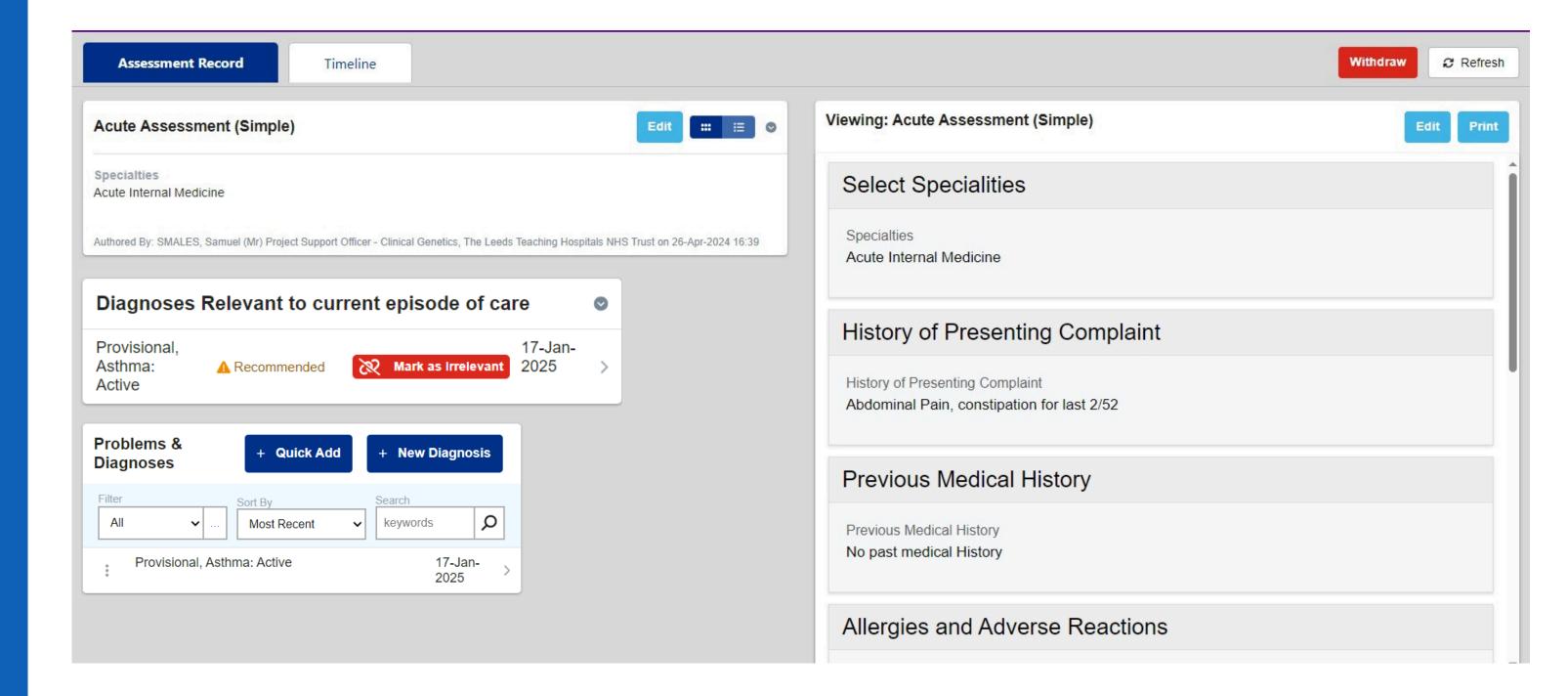


Viewing, Editing, Printing and Withdrawing a Completed Assessment Record eForm/Dashboard

Navigate to the Patient's Single Patient View and click on the Assessment Record eForm and associated dashboard, you wish to view. In this User Guide, we will be looking at the Acute Assessment (Simple) Assessment Record eForm/Dashboard.



The Assessment Record eForm and associated Assessment Record Dashboard will appear.



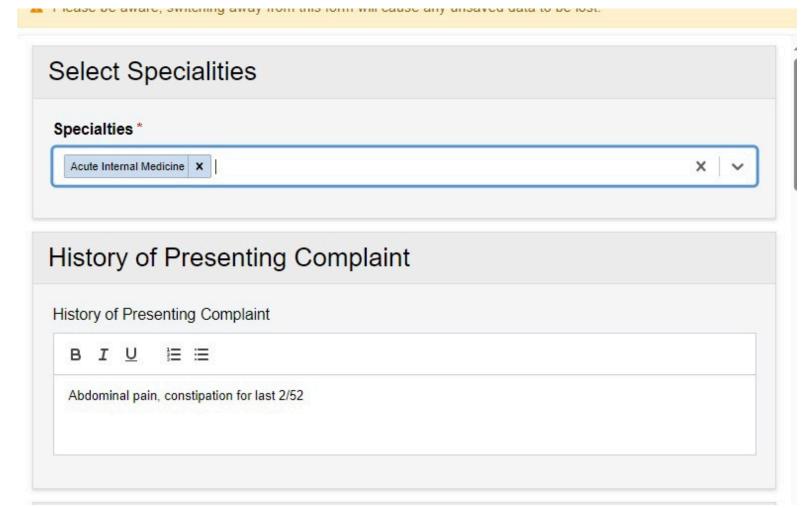
If you are unable to interact with all the widgets within the **Assessment Record** Dashboard, you will need to click on the **Reset to Current Time button.**

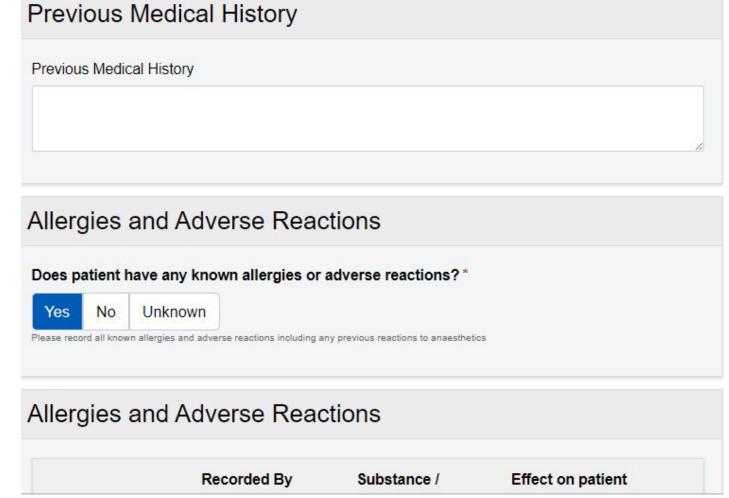
Reset to Current Time

Click on the **Edit** button to make any **amendments** to the **Assessment Record eForm.**

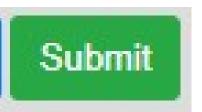


The Assessment Record eForm will open on the right hand side of the screen. You will be able to make any necessary amendments.





When you have finished editing the eForm, click on the Submit button.

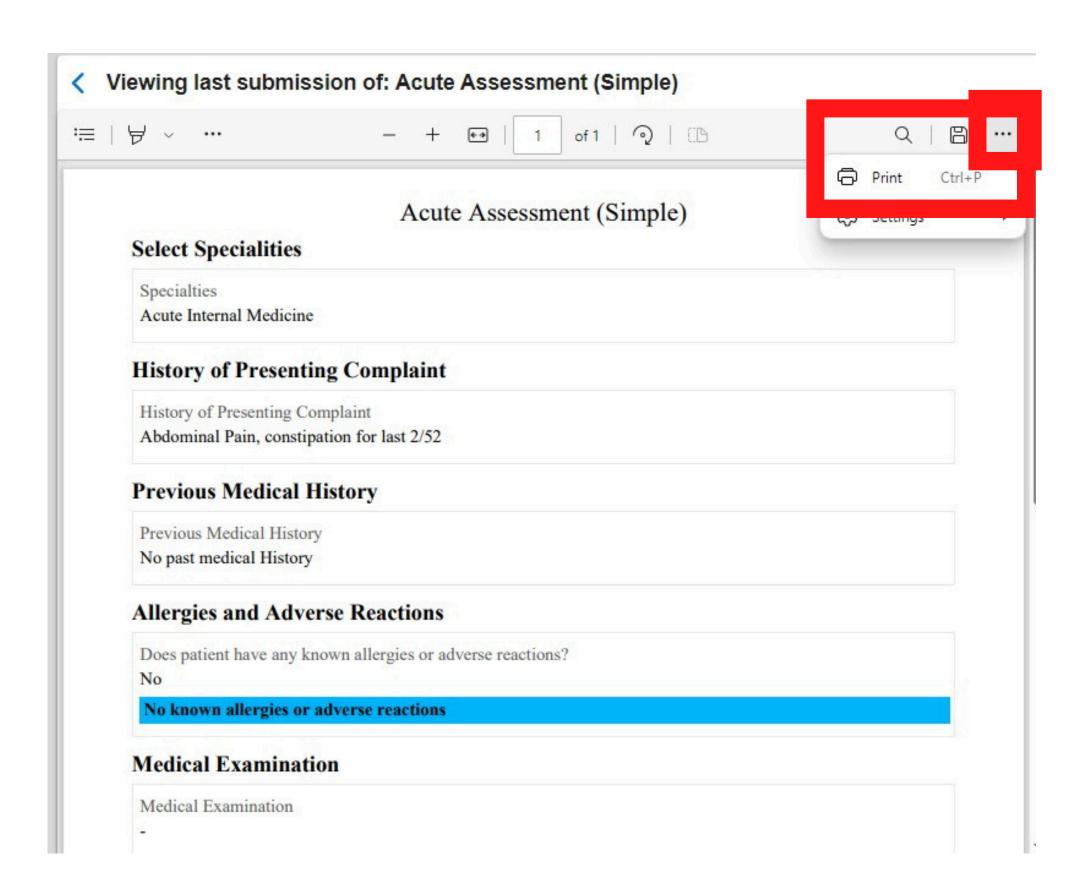




It is possible to **Print** out a completed **Assessment** eForm. Within the Assessment Record Dashboard for the associated Assessment Record eForm, click on the **Print** button.



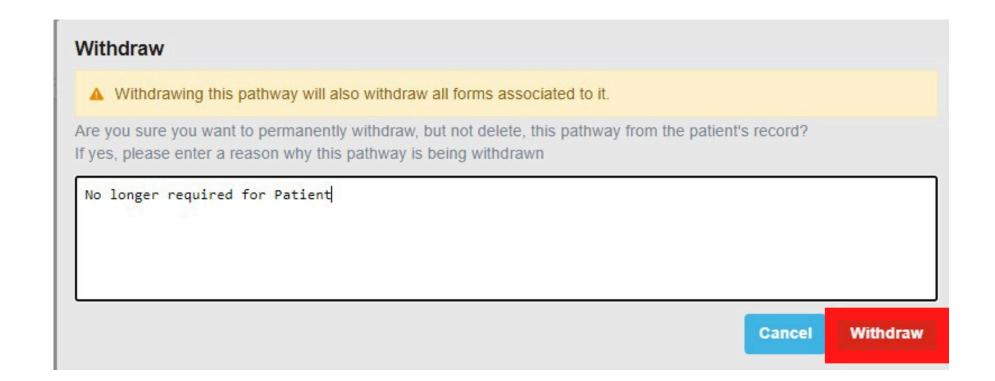
A PDF of the completed **Assessment Record eForm** will open on the right hand side of the screen. Click on the 3 dots and then click on Print.



It is possible to **Withdraw** a completed Assessment Record eForm. Within the **Assessment Record Dashboard** for the associated Assessment eForm, click on the Withdraw button.



A window will pop up. Document the reason you are removing the **Assessment Record eForm** for the Patient and then click on Withdrawn. The Assessment Record Dashboard will then be displayed as below.



The Assessment Record Dashboard will then appear like this.

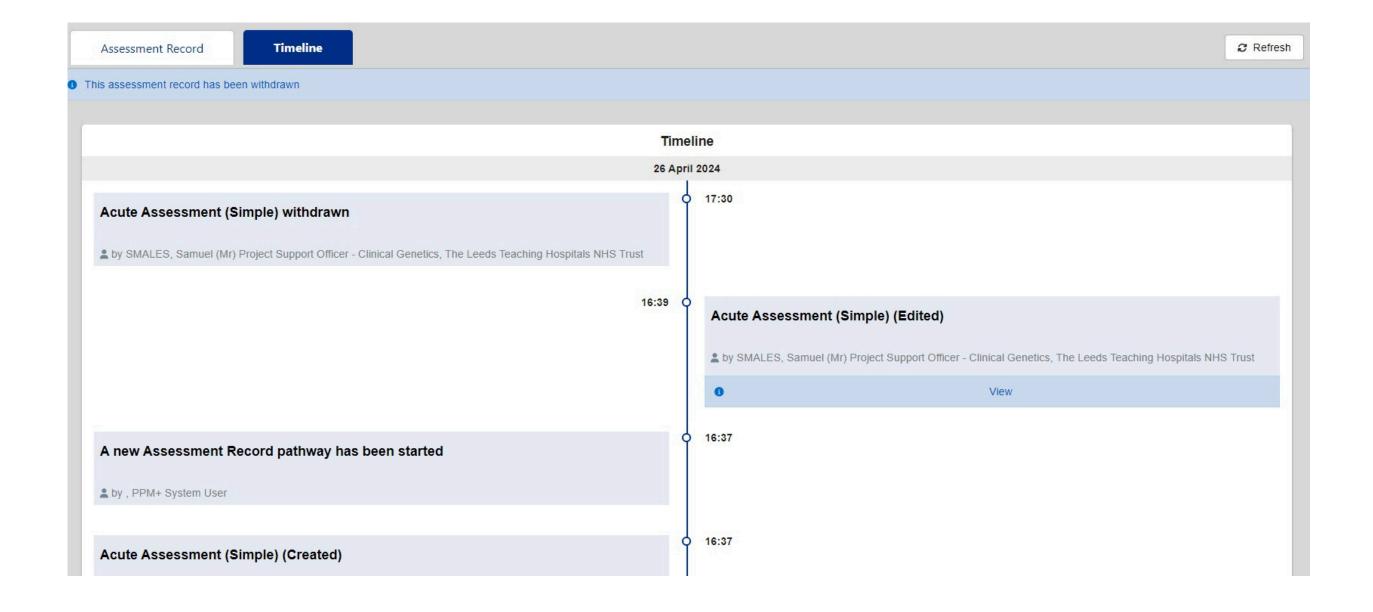


Timeline

Click on the **Timeline** tab to view the **timeline** for the **Assessment Record's Dashboard**.
