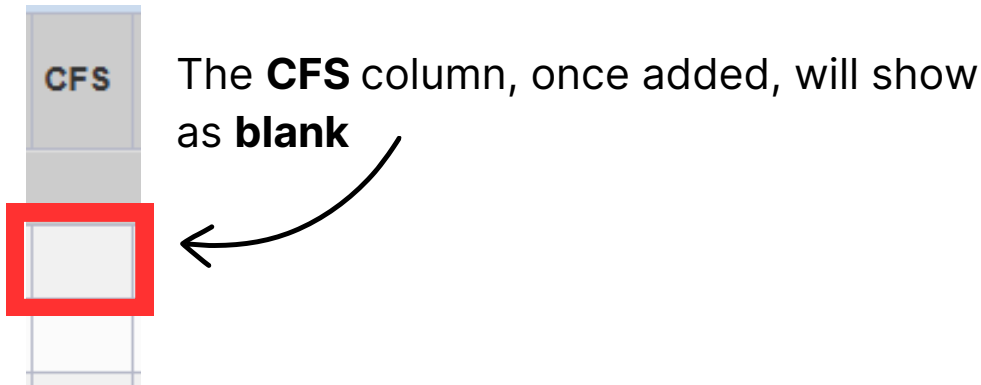


Clinical Frailty Score (CFS) Column Now Live in ppm+

On completion of the **Clinical Frailty Score (Rockwood) eForm**, the calculated score will become visible in this column
