

Hypoglycaemia Treatment Record for Adults With Diabetes eForm is now available in ppm+

This eForm is to be used for the recording of Adult patients with Diabetes, hypoglycaemic episodes in hospital. This eForm will capture patient's symptoms, capillary blood glucose pre and post treatment and also the treatment administered during a Hypoglycaemic episode.

By completing this eForm it will help to improve patient safety, reduce future hypoglycaemia recurrence and facilitate continuity of care.

This eForm is vital for reporting purposes and to make sure the Trust is meeting national standards for the correct management of hypoglycaemic episodes of Adult patients with Diabetes.

The **Hypoglycaemia Treatment Record for Adults With Diabetes** can be completed via the **PPM+ mobile app** and the **desktop version of PPM+**.



The **eForm** can be accessed via **eForms** in the **PPM+ Mobile** app or by using the **Add Clinical Document** function on the **desktop version of PPM+**.

Enter **Hypoglycaemia Treatment Record for Adults With Diabetes** in the **Search Field** and select **Hypoglycaemia Treatment Record for Adults With Diabetes**. You can also save this to your **favourites** by clicking on the **star**.
