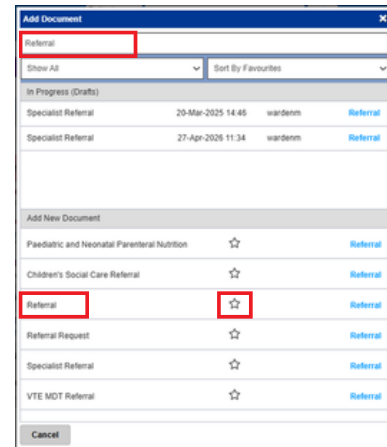


Coming Soon - The Paediatric Vascular Access Teams using the New Specialist Referrals Pathway in ppm+

From 28th September 2026, the Specialist Referrals Pathway to the Paediatric Vascular Access Teams will be changing, and Specialist Referrals can no longer be submitted using the current Specialist Referrals Pathway. 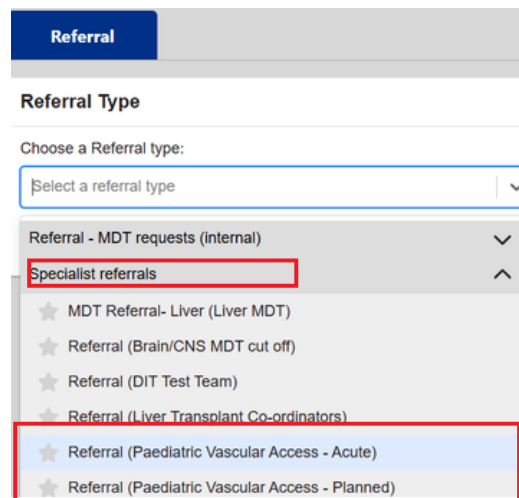
The new **Specialist Referrals Pathway** can be accessed via **eForms** in the **PPM+ Mobile app** or by using the **Add Clinical Document** function on the **desktop version** of **PPM+** as shown here.

Enter **Referral** in the search field and select the eForm. You can also save this to your favourites by clicking on the **star icon**.



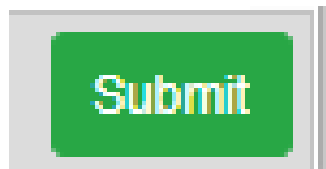
