

#### How to add the Sideroom Availability **eForm**

- The **eForm** is called **Sideroom Availability Form**. To find out how to add an eForm/Clinical Document via the Desktop version of PPM+, please follow the Clinical Document guide by Clicking Here.

#### Completing the Sideroom Availability eForm

Staff should complete a form when a patient goes into a sideroom, when a patient can be removed from a sideroom or when the patient's isolation period changes.


Please see local Infection Prevention and Control policies for guidance around isolation periods for infection as per the instruction on the form. Just to identify there is guidance to support the staff with decision making.



Upon opening the eForm, there will be three main sections, once you select the option, the form will then show like this.

Selecting the option **Infection** Prevention will provide the option to input the **Main Infection Prevention Reason** using the search bar or the drop down menu.

Selecting **Protective Isolation** does not require the user to input any further information, however Other Reasons will generate a list of other common reasons a patient may need to be in a Sideroom, select the relevant option.






The next section on the **Sideroom** Availability eForm will ask for Other Isolation Reasons. Again, selecting some answers will require the user to input additional information, such as additional infection risks. More than one can be selected.




Selecting **Other** will allow the user to input additional information also, or there is also the option to select None, if there is no additional reasoning. It is possible to select **Infection** and **Other** at this point, if it is relevant to the patient.



The final part of the **eForm** is the Outcome section. There is an option here to input how long the patient needs to remain in a **Sideroom**. If selecting Must remain in isolation for duration of isolation, type reasoning in the free text box that will appear upon selection.




**Isolation Period Incomplete** should be input if a patient needs to remain in a sideroom for a set amount of time, this then generates a report for **Bed** Managers and allows them to more easily allocate isolation space to patients who need a sideroom.




Once the **eForm** is completed, select **Submit.** The **Sideroom Availability** eForm should be completed when a patient enters a sideroom. A new one should be completed each time a patient's isolation period is extended.




#### How to View and Withdraw a completed Sideroom Availability eForm in PPM+


Once submitted, the **eForm** can be located on the patient's Single Patient View.



From here, it is possible to Withdraw the eForm as well as view the Audit Timeline, Print and Expand the view of the eForm.



Selecting **Expand** will provide a full view of the submitted **eForm** rather than a compact view.




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





**Print** will allow the user to print the eForm as a document version.



The **Audit Timeline** allows the user to view who has created and edited the eForm as well as when.



If an eForm has been completed incorrectly. for example if it has been added to the record of the wrong patient, the option to Withdraw allows the user to Withdraw the eForm from the patient's record.
