

Accessing eMeds via PPM+

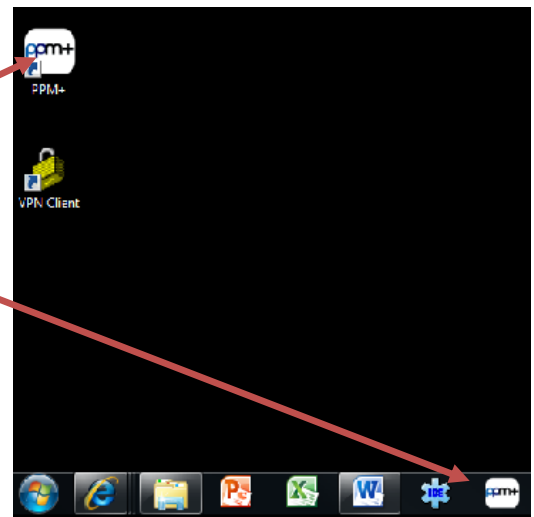
There are two ways to access eMeds. You can either log in via PPM+ or by eMeds direct through web applications.

We recommend that you access eMeds through PPM+ where possible. PPM+ is the Trusts electronic records base; a central database which stores in-depth clinical information about our patients from various electronic systems. Accessing eMeds via PPM+ allows you to view patients in relation to their bed number; thereby reducing drug errors and increasing patient safety.

Below is a demonstration of how to gain access to eMeds via PPM+.

Step1

The quickest way to log into ppm+ is via the icon on the desk top



Step2

Enter PPM+ Username and Password



To access eMeds click on the blue drop down box next to the patient you want to administer medications to and click on eMeds
