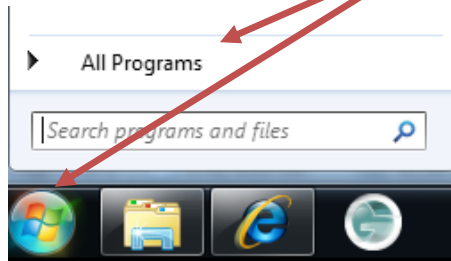


Accessing eMeds Directly

If PPM+ was unavailable or experiencing technical issues eMeds can be accessed directly as shown below.

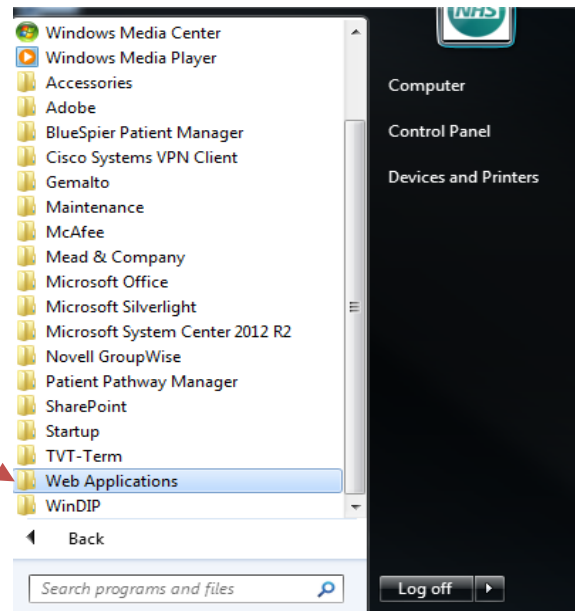
Step 1

Click the start button at the bottom left of the desktop screen, then All Programmes



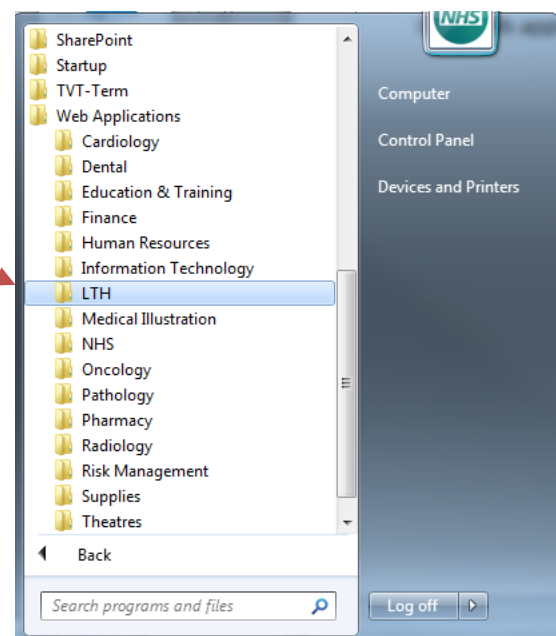
Step 2

Step 3

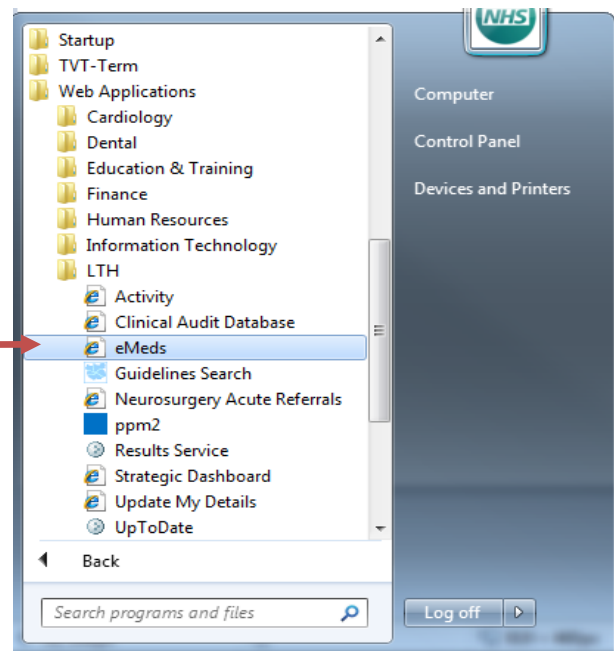

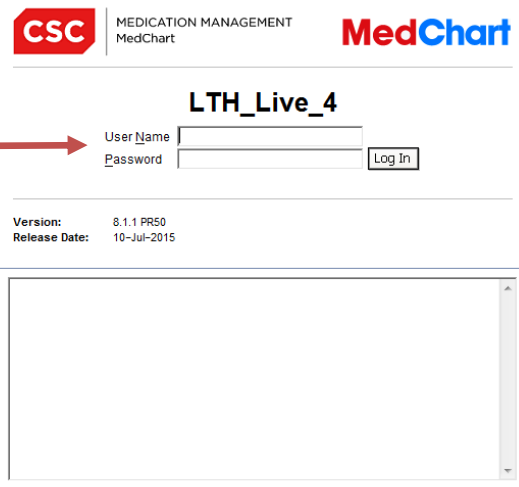
