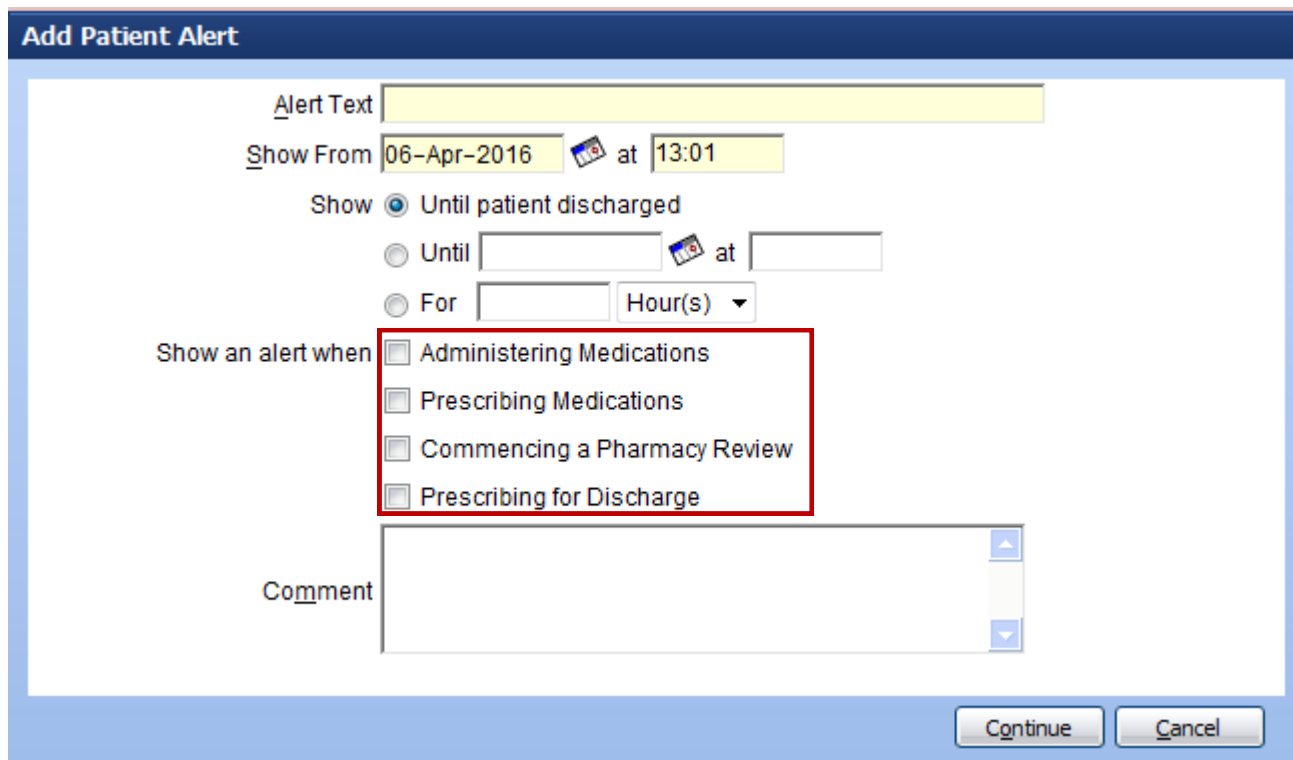


Within the eMeds system you are able to add alerts. These can be used by members of the MDT as a way of highlighting any information regarding medication which you feel other staff members should be aware of. These alerts can be set to appear on different pages of the system relating to the four options shown below.

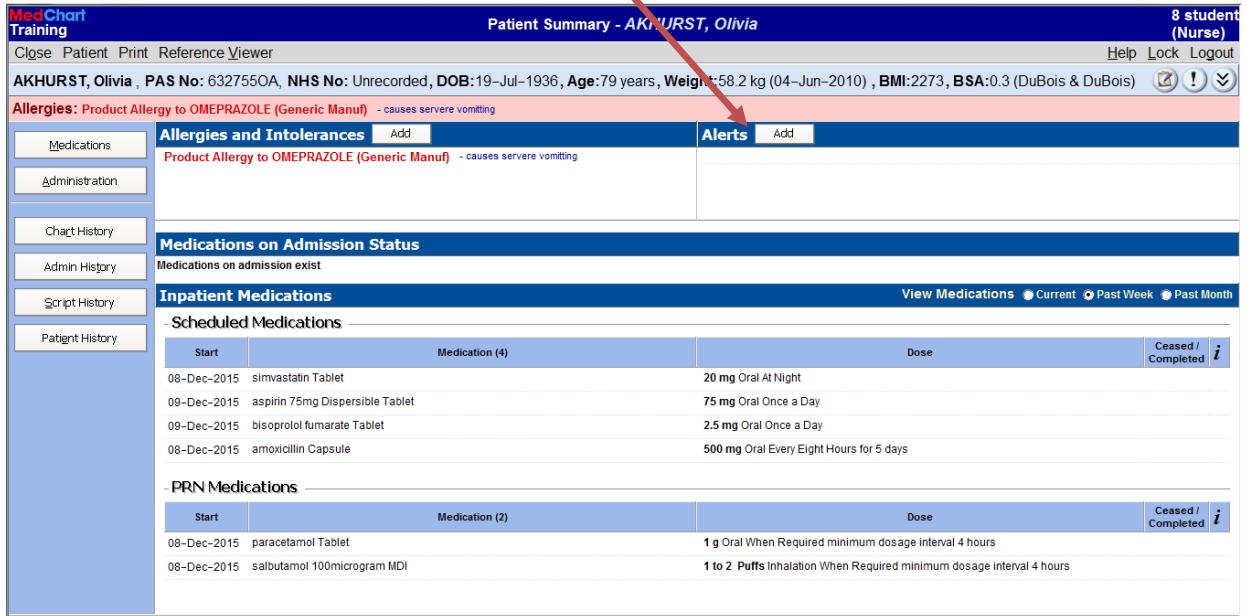


Below are examples of when you may choose to add each of these alerts

Show alert when	Example of when this may be used
Administering medications	Patient has right sided weakness and requires support taking medications
Prescribing medications	Patient would prefer soluble paracetamol; if appropriate please review
Commencing a pharmacy review	Patient would prefer soluble paracetamol; if appropriate please review
Prescribing for discharge	Patient would prefer medications in a dosette box on discharge if appropriate

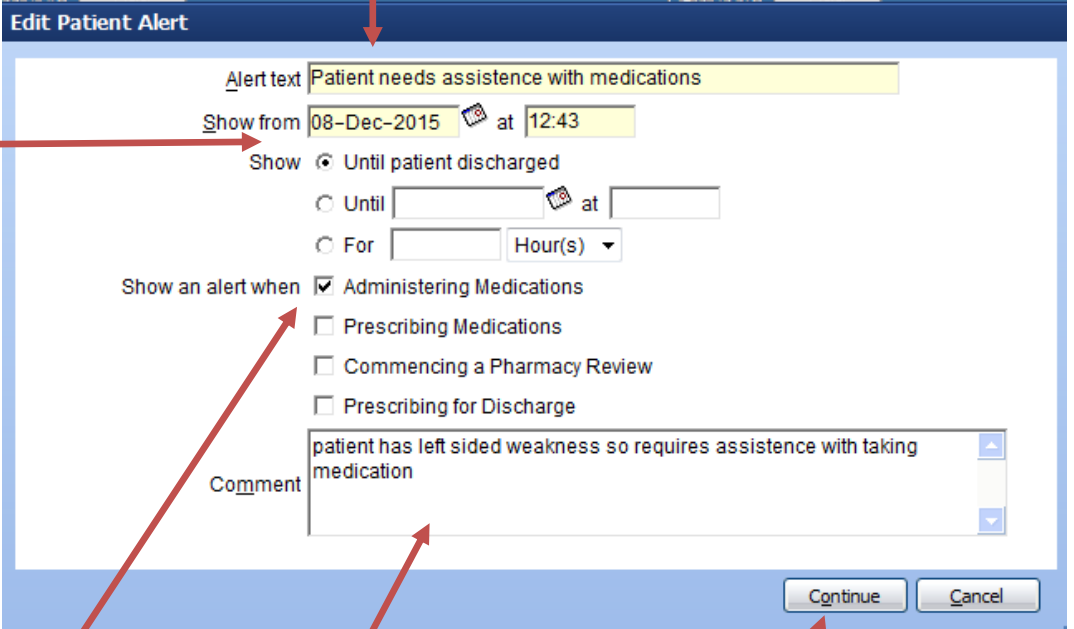

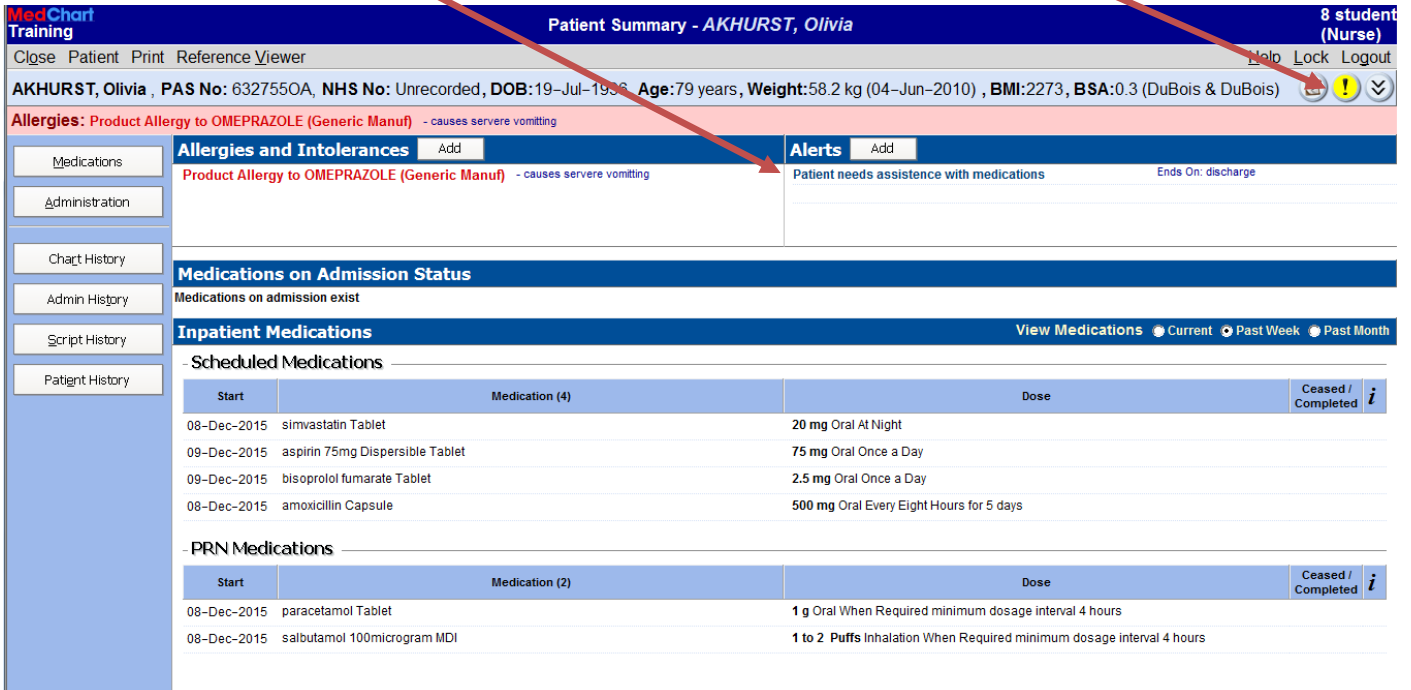

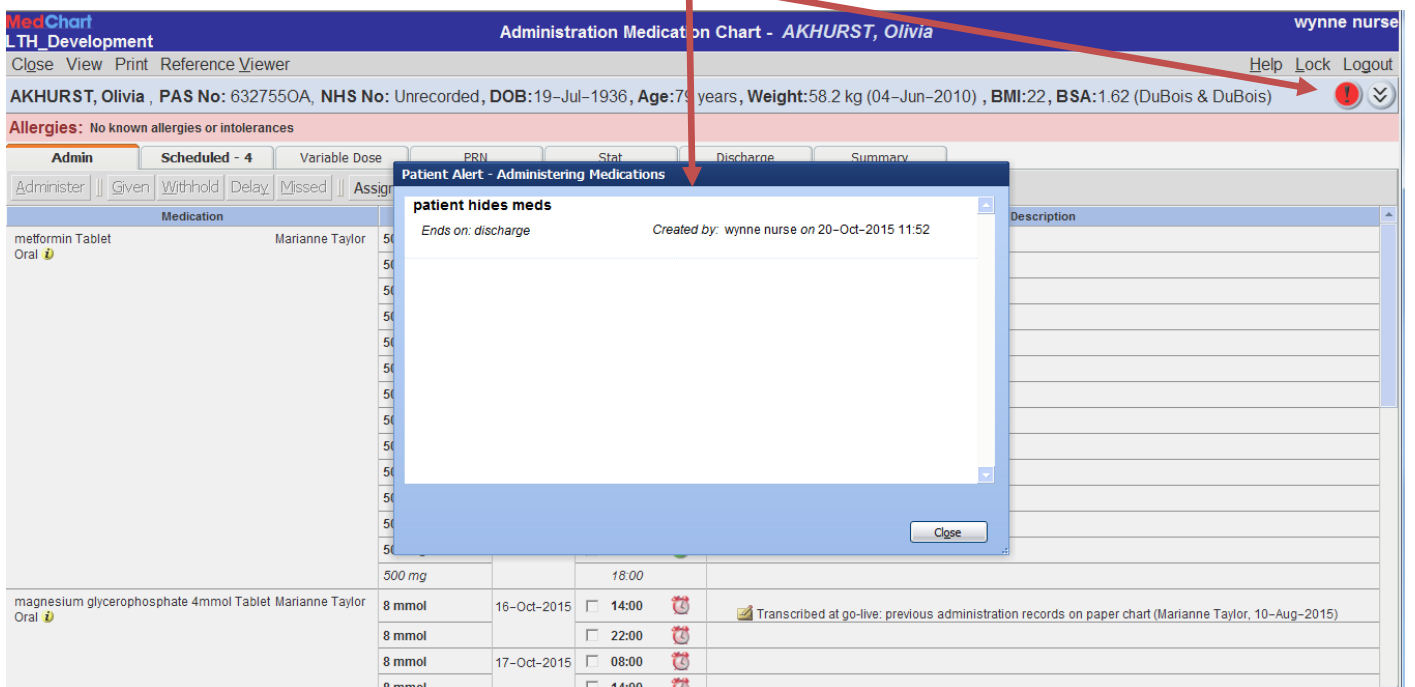
